Scriptures:

Col 1:9-12 ⁹For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you. We continually ask God to fill you with the knowledge of his will through all the wisdom & understanding that the Spirit gives, ¹⁰so that you may live a life worthy of the Lord & please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work, growing in the knowledge of God, ¹¹being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance & patience, ¹² & giving joyful thanks to the Father, who has qualified you to share in the inheritance of his holy people in the kingdom of light.

Rom 12:1-3 ¹Therefore, I urge you, brothers & sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy & pleasing to God—this is your true & proper worship. ²Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test & approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing & perfect will. ³For by the grace given me I say to every one of you: Do not think of yourself more highly than you ought, but rather think of yourself with sober judgment, in accordance with the faith God has distributed to each of you.

James 1:2-12 ²Consider it pure joy, my brothers & sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, ³because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. ⁴Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature & complete, not lacking anything. ⁵If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, & it will be given to you. ⁶But when you ask, you must believe & not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown & tossed by the wind. ⁷That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord. ⁸Such a person is double-minded & unstable in all they do. ⁹Believers in humble circumstances ought to take pride in their high position. ¹⁰But the rich should take pride in their humiliation—since they will pass away like a wild flower. ¹¹For the sun rises with scorching heat & withers the plant; its blossom falls & its beauty is destroyed. In the same way, the rich will fade away even while they go about their business. 12 Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

Observe: What speaks to you?

-People are praying for you daily to bear fruit, grow in Christ, & to have endurance.

Rom 12:1-3 -You must renew your mind & thought patterns.

- -Your thoughts do effect every part of your being.
- -You cannot live conformed to the world but you can live conformed to Christ.

James 1:2-12 -Remember tests are opportunities for our faith to grow.

- -Faith produces perseverance.
- -Believe that if you ask God for wisdom to live He will give it to you.
- -Focus on God & what His word tells you

Apply: What can you do today

Start praying for others in this crisis:

begin praying for your family, our leaders, neighbors, friends, against the virus etc.

Get into God's Word & remember:

God's Word promises power, strength, & peace. you have to renew your mind daily, changing thought patterns from this world to a heavenly perspective.

See the opportunities that God gives you:

in everyone of life's moments—trial, temptation, challenge, or victory remember growth is never comfortable but it can be an enjoyable experience if we see it through the lens of Christ.

In times of crisis:

remember that God's people do not face their crisis alone; they have divine help.

keep your eyes on God because things may get worse before they get better.

you should pray the promises of God. rely on God, not yourself.

Don't live in fear. Know that God is in control.

Pray:

Heavenly Father, Your grace is beyond us. We cannot comprehend Your power. I praise You because You have given Your Word to us for us to hear Your voice & to grow in Christ. Thank You for Your Holy Spirit & the presence it has in our lives. Forgive us where we haven't put You first, where we have trusted ourselves instead of You.
